

PISTE & PARK USAGE POLICY

PISTE

- Respect all other slope users
- Control your speed
- Always give way to skiers / riders below and choose a route past so as not to endanger or alarm them
- Leave plenty of space when overtaking
- Look up and down the slope before starting or entering on to the slope
- Always stop in a clearly visible place or, preferably at the side of the slope
- When climbing up or down the slope always keep to the side
- Respect all signage
- In the event of an accident everybody is duty bound to assist and witnesses should provide relevant information of any accident

PARK

- Ride at least once through the park at slow speed before use to familiarise yourself with the features
- Only use the features for your ability. Freestyle terrain can be dangerous and can cause serious injury. You are responsible for, and assume all risk of injury and possible death
- Be courteous and respect others
- Look before you leap. Never jump blindly, use a spotter when necessary
- It is your responsibility to control your body on the ground and in the air
- You must wait for people downhill of you to clear the area before you start your descent
- Always clear the landing areas as quickly as possible
- Only one person at any one time on a feature
